How to Register: Student Guide

 Go to www.startprofile.com and click **Register**

 Enter your first name, surname, school email address, postcode and gender

Tip: if you forget your username or password we will use the email address you provide to send you a reminder


 Choose a memorable username and a secure password and click **Get Started**

 It will then ask you to log on with the log on details you have just created.

You then click:


 I am studying in education and would like to explore my career options.


 Select Sir Thomas Boteler from the drop down list of schools.

 Select your year group.

 It then asks for registration code but this is optional.

 Submit and it takes you into the site.

 Select your year group.

 Your profile will appear and it will then allow you to explore the site in terms of jobs and courses available.

STARTProfile

- Use the platform to start researching your career journey, your likes and dislikes for your future profession. Develop your knowledge about the world of work, increase your knowledge about your self and develop knowledge about your education.
- Build up your profile on START – this will be your careers platform throughout school
- The modules on Start help you to navigate your way through all the information and advice so that you're better prepared to make your education and career-related choices.

Each module contains a number of short activities that you can do in the classroom, at home or anywhere you have access to Start.

Go to activities and modules – view all activities

- *Exploring your future* - broaden your horizons, where could your career take you and what might your future look like?
- *Improving your employability* – develop and demonstrate your skills and abilities, what does it take to be successful at work?
- *Making your choices* – prepare for moments of choice, what are my options and which pathways are right for me?

Build up your profile

- Add into your locker all the career activities you have completed in school over the past year or two:
